

- 1. No motorized vehicles of any kind allowed on grass or public right-of-way's. Please tread lightly on main park roads.
- 2. No one is allowed to possess any dangerous controlled substances including, but not limited to firearms and explosives within the park.
- 3. Everyone entering the park must read, sign, and fully understand ALL aspects of the park liability waiver. Those under the age of 18 MUST present a notarized waiver form signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian, if parent or LEGAL guardian is not present to sign in the presence of a park staff member, you must provide a notarized copy. Parent/LEGAL guardian must closely supervise minors. Proof of Identity required. (Wavier form valid for 1 Year, you do not need to fill one out each trip.)
- 4. DO NOT LITTER! Place litter in an appropriate trash receptacle. ("PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT")
- 5. Do not remove or destroy trees, shrubs, plants or animals.
- 6. **NO HUNTING** allowed in the park.
- 7. ALL FIRES MUST BE IN APPROVED GRILL OR ANOTHER CONTAINER. ALL FIRES MUST BE CONTAINED. DO NOT LEAVE FIRE UNATTENDED!
- 8. Registration is from 9 AM until 6 PM Monday through Thursday, 9 AM until 8 PM on Friday & Saturday, and 9 AM until 4 PM on Sundays, except on special events promoted by Muddy Buddy's. Other check in times by appointment.
- 9. HELMETS and proper safety gear are required at all times for all children and during ALL RACES while vehicle is in motion.

 All Off-road Vehicle drivers and riders should follow the manufactures safe operating procedures.
- 10. Passengers are allowed in SUV's but must sign a Release and Waiver of Liability Form, and must also wear their seat belt at all times in the vehicle. Anyone not signing a waiver is considered a trespasser and may be prosecuted.
- 11. All SUV's must have a fully enclosed metal cab and/roll bar protection, functioning safety belts, working four-wheel drive system, frame mounted (not welded) tow hooks that are appropriately rated for the vehicles weight for recovery purposes, and must be in good and safe mechanical operating condition.
- 12. Please be courteous of other drivers and park employees on and off the trails.
- 13. Everyone rides at his or her own risk. Know your limitation and do not exceed the capabilities of your vehicle.
- 14. Failure to apply with the above rules, regulations and safe operating procedures can result in you being temporarily or permanently banned from using the park or participating in any future park activities or events.
- 15. THE PARK IS NEITHER LIABLE, NOR RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE, LOSS OR THEFT OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OR INJURY TO VISITORS
- 16. NO GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED IN THE PARK.
- 17. Please be sure that your ORV has the appropriate equipment needed to operate on the rough terrain in the park.
- 18. **There will be NO tolerance for fighting.** Any violation of this rule will result in a \$100.00 park fine, and potentially being banned from the property and being arrested.
- 19. **Any Off-road vehicle operating after 9 pm must have stock type mufflers installed on bikes and be reasonably quiet**. The only exception to this rule is for racing bikes during scheduled park events. Consideration of neighbors and campers in park is necessary! If you witness a rider posing a threat to themselves or others, report it to park officials IMMEDIATELY!!
- 20. Absolutely NO ATV or motorized vehicles allowed to be driven in the lake.
- 21. NO RIDING outside the park boundaries, main roads, or thru private property adjoining the park. If it is a marked or barricaded, THERE IS A REASON! Don't bother saying "I didn't know".
- 22. ABSOLUTELY NO Road or Mud Riding in the 35 ACRE Camp Ground. (Example = Riding in ditches, branches, stirring up dirt, dust or cutting donuts) YOU will be PERMANENTLY BANNED from the park!
- 23. Every vehicle MUST do 10 MPH or Idle Speed thru Camp Ground or MAIN Road.
- 24. When Crossing Main Road or the Trail use CAUTION, and Idle Speed in front of Guard Shack.
- 25. When Riding your ATV Please stay OFF Main Road. Due to the traffic, congestion, and risk of injuries with people Entering and Exiting Park.
- 26. DO NOT RIDE THRU CAMPSITES, POWER BOXES, OR LAKE YOU WILL BE FINED FOR DAMAGES AND BANNED FROM PARK.
